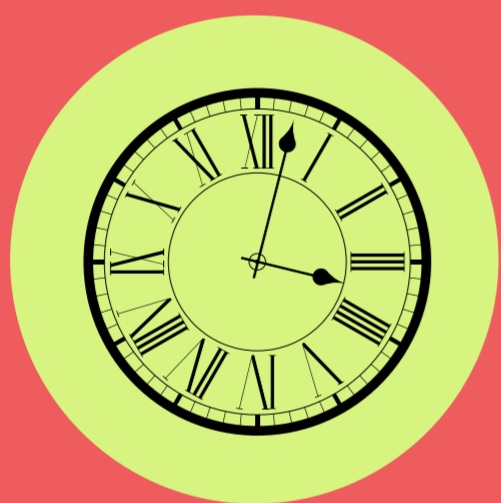

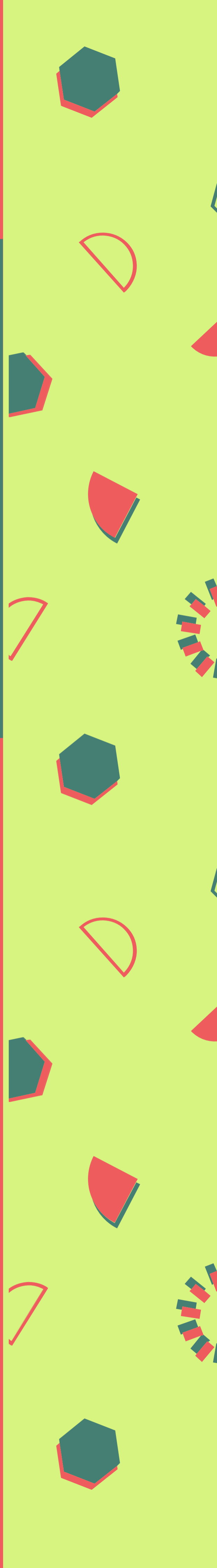

Main aim and objectives

The main aim of “Youth Discovering Erasmus+” Project LAB E+ I is to encourage you to use Erasmus+ within your contexts and increase the participation of young people in international youth work through the Erasmus+: youth in action programme. The project LAB will create the necessary working environment for organizations/informal groups that are active locally in the youth field to create sustainable networks and partnerships for the development of future projects, and support and facilitate cooperation, project ideas, designing, writing and implementation of projects. Support will be offered throughout the process, and in case of successful applications, during the implementation and evaluation phase.

Specific objectives

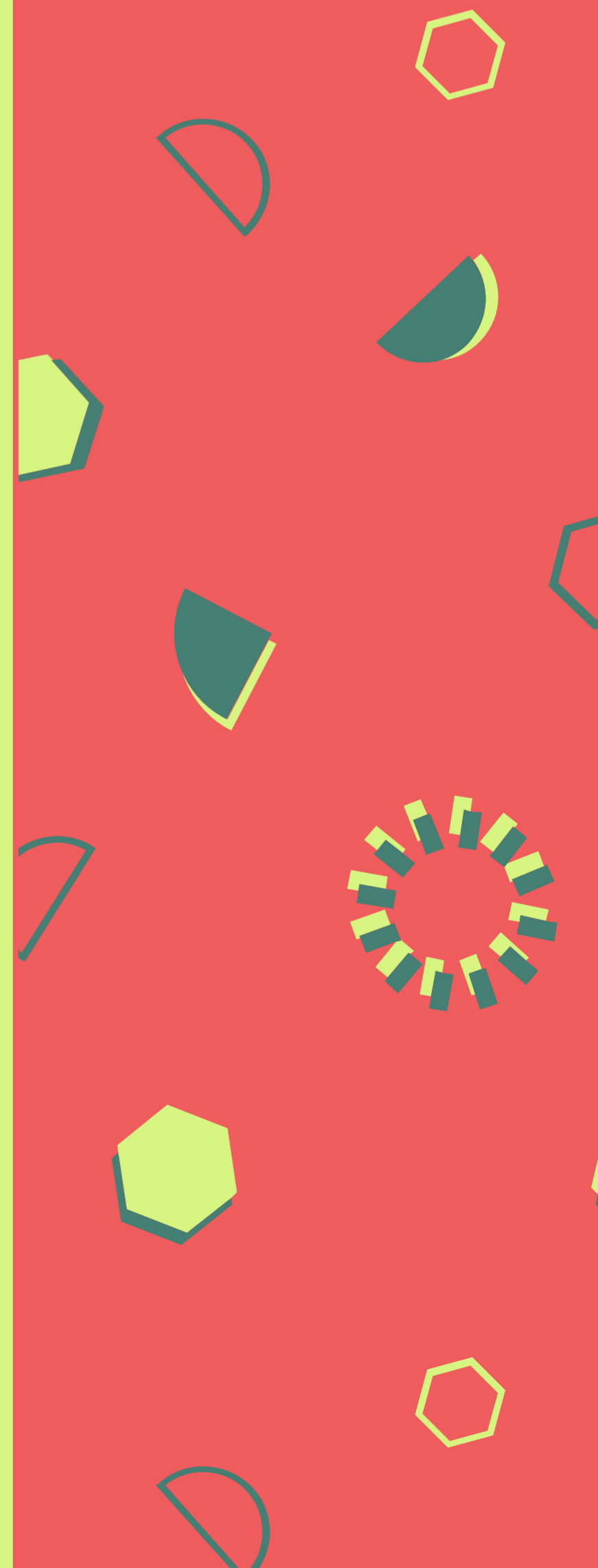
- To increase the participation of young people and organisations in the Erasmus+: Youth in Action programme;
- To encourage and support the strategic use of Erasmus+ as a tool for inclusion & capacity building of organisations;
- To increase the capacity of organisations for international youth work;
- To support establishment of long-term quality partnerships;
- To gather and promote results & good practices on national and transnational level.

Expected outcomes

- The participants are expected to develop new partnerships and project ideas and should be able to submit an application to E+: Youth in Action programme in one of the following rounds after the project LAB;
- Increase the number and the quality of projects submitted by organisations/informal groups coming from disadvantaged areas;
- Increase the participation of young people from disadvantaged areas in E+: Youth in Action Programme;
- Develop new partnerships and projects among the participating organizations;
- Increase competences of participants to better understand core principles of developing quality inclusion projects involving specific target groups;

Training methods used & main activities

The use of non-formal education methodologies will ensure the active participation of all individuals involved. Working groups and active methods will be used in order to create an environment that encourages a dynamic involvement of all and the development of project ideas. The diversity of approaches will be applied in order to engage participants and facilitate the contribution from all in the discussed topics.



Profile of the participants:

The participants should:

- know the E+: Youth in Action Programme and its priorities;
- Work actively with young people and be able to involve them;
- Know how to support non-formal education learning process;
- Know the basics of project management;
 - Be interested and motivated to build partnerships and develop a project idea;
 - Be able to work in English.

This project LAB is for the maximum of 50 participants, 10 from each partner country (Portugal, Estonia, Belgium, Romania and Slovenia)

and recommended for:

- Youth workers and Youth leaders with active roles in organisations coming from disadvantaged areas with the profile above mentioned and that have preferably attended or are willing to attend the prior national information & training sessions linked to this activity.
